ROUND BUSH – AUGUST 2025

Paul led us on a 7 mile walk from the Round Bush pub via Aldenham, the Mundens estate and Bricket Wood.

The present Mundens house is known to date from before 1795 as there are pictures dated such in the British Library. Additions were made in 1829 and then extensively in the late 19th Century as the Victorian fashion developed for larger Country Houses. Further extensive alterations were made in the 1990's to bring the house up to modern standards as a comfortable family home whilst retaining its former historic past. The gardens were laid out in the early part of the 19th Century along with many of the woods and trees in the Park, some of which are over 200 years old. Munden House is a member of Historic Houses but the property is not open to the public.
