

March 2022 – Kings Langley

It was a glorious spring sunny day when 27 intrepid walkers set out on a circular 5.8-mile trek. Starting in Kings Langley we went through the churchyard of All Saints Church, a mediaeval church with parts dating from the 13th century. Edmund of Langley (1341 – 1402), the fifth son of Edward III and the first Duke of York is entombed there.

From there we followed the canal path and then crossed over the A41 and walked through Wayside Farm. Up a long winding hill, across the footbridge over the A41 bypass and through some woodland, more fields and eventually the outskirts of Chipperfield Common.

We then joined the Herts Way passed through many fields and paddocks and eventually back into Kings Langley.

Now thirsty, the majority of us enjoyed a good lunch and a welcome drink at the Rose & Crown pub.
