

WELCOME TO DENBIES WINE ESTATE, DORKING SURREY

Denbies Wine Estate in Dorking is one of England's largest single estate vineyards. The estate, independently owned and run, comprises of 380 acres with 265 acres currently under vine, it has a production capacity of 1 million bottles. The first vines were planted on the estate in 1986.

For the last 20 years, Christopher White, CEO, has owned and operated the estate. Under his leadership, Denbies has become one of the largest and most successful wineries in England.

Over the years they have welcomed several members of the Royal family to the estate, completing the historical connections which date back to Prince Albert in 1851.

The Estate now includes 200 acres of woodlands, and 10 estate houses.

The vineyards of Denbies Estate are situated on the North Downs, in the town of Dorking, with its famous chalky soil, in a protected valley of south facing slopes (AONB). It now produces some of the finest sparkling and table wines in Europe through repeated certification in the annual International Wine awards.
