Fun with Wine by Angie and Maggie – Tuesday 5th July 2022

1. Royal Tokaji Dry Tokaji - 13% - 8.99 (12.99)

Hungarian – Co founded by writer Hugh Johnson made from 100% Furmint grape. Aromas of apple, pear, honey and blossom – ideal with rich dishes like pork belly with honey glaze.

2. Brundlmayer G V 2018 – 13% - 24.99 (34.99)

Austrian – made from vines with an average age of 45 years. Its fresh and delicate and yet remarkably rich, flavours of yellow fruit, apple, citrus and peppery spice – try with casseroles

3. Santa Julia Organic Wine Torrontes - 14% - 8.99

Argentinean – hand harvested grapes – suitable for Vegans – Torrontes a uniquely Argentine grape it's a crisp wine – flavours of citrus, pear and peach with a spicy finish – serve with salads, chicken

4. Qveris Rkatsiteli - 12.5% - 11.99 (13.99)

Georgian wine made in a traditional style. Grapes are macerated in their skins and buried in a large dry vessel to ferment. Rkatsiteli is one of the oldest grapes in the world. Flavours of of apricot and pear good with barbequed lamb.

5. Brazin Old Vine Zinfandel -15% - 14.99

Californian – made from vines 40 to 100 years old – family owned vineyards bountiful rich, dark berries fuse with plums and figs punctuated with notes of vanilla mocha and pepper

6. Incanta Pinot Noir – 12.5% - 6.49 (7.99)

Romanian Englishman Philip Cox and his Romanian wife Elvira have continued the wine making tradition as it was meant to be – grapes have been grown on the site since 1447 but it is only in the last 30 years that Philip and Elvira have managed to combine lots of family plots to create a distinctive vineyard large enough to export. Fruity, black cherry and light – can be served chilled with charcuterie.
