The nose is vibrant with hints of toast and flowers leading to a palate of citrus and ripe fruit. Flavours – honey, bread, citrus fruit. The perfect Champagne to elevate the flavours of fish and chips.

Raspberry-rich Grenache, with herby Syrah and Carignan, Cabalié has impressive concentration. That's due to the maturity of the vines, most well over 50 years old. The tiny berries they produce give Cabalié extraordinarily rich, ripe flavours.
