1. Name of wine: **Touraine (Sauvignon Blanc) 12%**
Country: France
Where bought: Aldi
Price: £6.49
Characteristics: Fresh bright and crisp. Classic aromatic notes are complemented by green apple and gooseberry aromas, with fresh lemony flavours and hints of zesty lime. Good with seafood and sushi.
2. Name of wine: **The Falls (Riesling) 11%**
Country: Canada
Where bought: Aldi
Price: £7.99
Characteristics: Captures a delicate balance of fruits, vital scents and acidity that lingers into citrus flavours. Cool fermentation and minimal handling maintains freshness and elegance.
3. Name of wine: **Eloisa (Viognier) Limited Collection - 13.5%**
(Eloisa means “chosen one” and was made to celebrate the ninth generation of the de Pedregal family).
Country: Chile
Where bought: Aldi
Price: £8.99
Characteristics: Attractive yellow colour with a hint of green. Deep, intense aromatic impression dominated by apricot and peach. On the palate it's creamy and sweet with a balance of elegance, structure and complexity. Its fruit flavours and soft floral notes are enhanced. Its perfect balance creates a long finish.
4. Name of wine: **Pierre Jaurant (Merlot) Limited Edition – 13.5%**
Country: France
Where bought: Aldi
Price: £5.79
Characteristics: Full and intense. An intense flavour with complex aromas of plum, blackberry and coffee. It boasts a silky texture and a wonderful long finish.
5. Name of wine: **Baron Amarillo (Priorat) 14%**
Country: Spain
Where bought: Aldi
Price: £12.99 (we paid £9.99)
Characteristics: A ruby red wine from the small Priorat region famed for its characterful wines. Full bodied and lively on the palate. It's well structured and bursting with personality. Floral rose aromas meet black cherry notes and aromatic herb flavours. Pairs well with lamb and wild game.
6. Name of wine: **Chassaux Et Fils (Rasteau) 14.5%**
Country: France
Where bought: Aldi
Price: £12.99 (we paid £9.99)
Characteristics: A beautiful and elegant red wine from the vineyards of the Southern Rhone Valley with long-lasting aromas. Voluptuous on the palate, its nose offers a complete bouquet of raspberries, blackcurrants, black pepper and liquorice. Pair with red meat and cheeses.
