We were regaled by Irene and Giles, two former teachers back in their favourite position in front of the class albeit with a slightly older group than they were used to. As they were just back from a holiday in South Africa they decided their theme would be South African wines, all bought from Morrisons.

Irene started with three whites:

1. Chenin Blanc Morrison's The Best, 13.5%, RRP £9
2. Sauvignon Blanc Morrison's The Best, 12.5%, RRP £9
3. Chardonnay Morrison's The Best, 13%, RRP £9

All the wines were well received, voting was 2, 5, 6 in favour of the Chardonnay.



Giles then presented the reds:

1. Pinotage Morrison's The Best, 13.5%, RRP £8.75
2. Shiraz Leopard's Leap, 13.5%, RRP £8.25
3. Cabernet Sauvignon Roodeberg Black, 12%, RRP £12

Although the first two red wines were enjoyed there was no hiding the 0, 0, 13 voting in favour of the Cabernet.

It was a very enjoyable and informative tasting session and with just the 13 of us we all enjoyed an extra glass or two.
