Another sociable and interesting wine tasting evening, led by David and Jan Marston.

Incredibly this was the end of our first year and we have managed to sample 71 bottles of wine, 1 bottle of champagne and 1 bottle of port, but who's counting!

This week we tasted three white wines:

- Sicilian Grillo (12.5%) £6.99 from Aldi
- Broglia Gavi from Italy (13.5%) £9 from Co-op
- Freixenet Pinot Grigio from Italy (11.5%) £10 from Morrisons

All of these wines were thoroughly enjoyable and very evenly ranked but the Pinot Grigio just came out in front.



Onto the reds:

- Colpasso Nero d'Avola from Sicily (14%) £9 from Morrisons
- Santodeno Negroamaro from Puglia in Italy (13.5%) £8 from Sainsbury's
- Piccini Leggero Appassimento from Puglia in Italy (14%) £6.50 from Morrisons

A very different ranking where these three wines are concerned. The first, which was very drinkable garnered no votes. By far the most popular was the Santodeno which attracted 82% of the total vote! The remaining votes went to the Piccini.
