We started off with an excellent Lanson champagne (12.5%); followed by a Gooseberry Bush sauvignon blanc (12%) from South Africa. and finally the last white was a Cabalie White (11.5%) from France. While obviously everyone enjoyed the champagne the favourite was the Cabalie. Prices were £28, £7.99 and £7.99.



Moving onto the reds, we started with a French Cabalie (13%) produced from the grenache grape, followed by an Opi Malbec (13%) from Argentina and finally a Black Stump Shiraz (14.5%) from Australia. Prices after discount were £7.99, £7.99 and £5.99 (list price £11.99!). The clear winner was the Black Stump.

All wines were purchased from Laithwaites apart from the champagne which came from Sainsbury's.
