The reds were also from three different countries - the first red (Primitivo, from Italy) was made using the appassimento method, the second Orovela Saperavistyle (from Georgia) and the last 667 Noble Vines Pinot Noir (from Calafornia). All quite full bodied being 13.5%, 13.5% and 14.5%. The Pinot was the most popular and the prices varied from £7.99, £11.99 and £11.99.
