As usual we started with three very pleasant whites:

Waimea Estate Sauvignon 2022 from New Zealand, 13.5%, RRP £12.99 we paid £10.99

Peter & Ulrich Griebeler Dry Riesling 2022 from Germany, Mosel 12.5% RRP £13.99 we paid £11.99

Domäne Wachau 'Weingärten Weissenkirchen' Grüner Veltliner Federspiel from Austria, Wachau 2021/22 13% RRP £13.99 we paid £11.99

The Sauvignon attracted the most votes, only just beating the Veltliner.



And now for the reds:

Santa Rita 'Medalla Real' Carménère 2019/21 from Chile, Colchagua Valley 14%, RRP £13.99 we paid £11.99

Viñalba 'Reserve' Malbec 2020/21 from Argentina, Mendoza 14.5%, £12.99 we paid £9.99

Kanonkop 'Kadette' Pinotage 2019/20, Stellenbosch from South Africa, 14.5%, RRP 15.99 we paid £12.99

Unlike the whites the Pinotage was a clear winner.
