We started with three sparkling white whites:

1. Tesco Finest Prosecco Valdobbiadene Superiore, Italy, 11%, we paid £10
2. Segura Viudas Brut Vintage Cava 2022, Spain, 12%, we paid £12
3. Tesco Finest Blanquette de Limoux 1531, France, 12%, we paid £10.50

Voting was 6, 0, 9 in favour of the Blanquette de Limoux, once again the price did not dictate the popularity which often happens with the whites.



Next the reds:

1. Portrait 2022, Shiraz, Australia, 14%, RRP £15.50, we paid £13
2. The Siding 2022, Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia, 13.4%, RRP £16, we paid £12.50
3. Devil's Corner 2023, Pinot Noir, Tasmania, 12.5%, we paid £15

Voting was 12, 1, 2. with the Portrait 2022 being by far away the most popular.

All of the wines were purchased from Tesco.

Once again, a thoroughly enjoyable evening was had by one and all.
