It was a pleasant walk up to 'The Kitchen' on Tuesday, the weather was bright and sunny and it left us in the mood for a refreshing glass of wine; luckily ours needs were met!

17 other walkers (albeit some came by car, some came by bike) made it to the venue where we were treated to six different wines presented by Paul and Mairi. A welcome change to the format in that we sampled 2 whites, 2 reds and 2 dessert wines.

We started with two whites:

Sancerre 2022, 13% RRP £16 from M&S but bought in France for £10.75

Gavi di Gavi from Italy, 13% RRP £13.99 we paid £11.99

The voting was 11 to 8 in favour of the Sancerre.



Onto the reds:

Domaine Fillatreau Vieilles Vignes 2018, 14.5% RRP £22 we paid £13.68 (from France)

Pasqua Passimento Rosso 2021, 14%, RRP £11.99 we paid £9.99

The Passimento was the clear winner with just over 84% of the votes cast.

This left us with the Dessert wines –

Coteaux De L'Aubance 2022, 13.5% this wine is not available in the UK but cost £8 in France

Royal Tokaji late Harvest 2017 (50cc), 12% we paid £13.99

Voting was close, 8 for the Coteaux and 11 for the Tokaji.
