We started with three whites:

- 1. Royal Tokaji, Hungary, 13%, RRP £13.00, we paid £12
- 2. Zocker Gruner Veltliner, California, 14%, RRP £17.50, we paid £11.50
- 3. Rustenberg Wild Ferm SB, South Africa. 13.5%, RRP £15, we paid £10

All of the white wines were extremely pleasant but the Zocker proved the most popular, voting was 6, 10, 6.



Next the reds:

- 1. Pinot Noir Naudin, France, 13%, RRP £11.50, we paid £9.50
- 2. 409 Ribera Del Dueor, Spain, 14%, RRP £13, we paid £12
- 3. The Barossan Shiraz, Australia, 14.5%, RRP £18.50, we paid £13

As we have found out over our many meetings, the most expensive red proved to be the most popular (pricing not known before the vote).

The Voting was 2, 6, 14.

All of the wines were purchase in Majestic.

A very enjoyable evening, with Monty bringing the average age way down!
